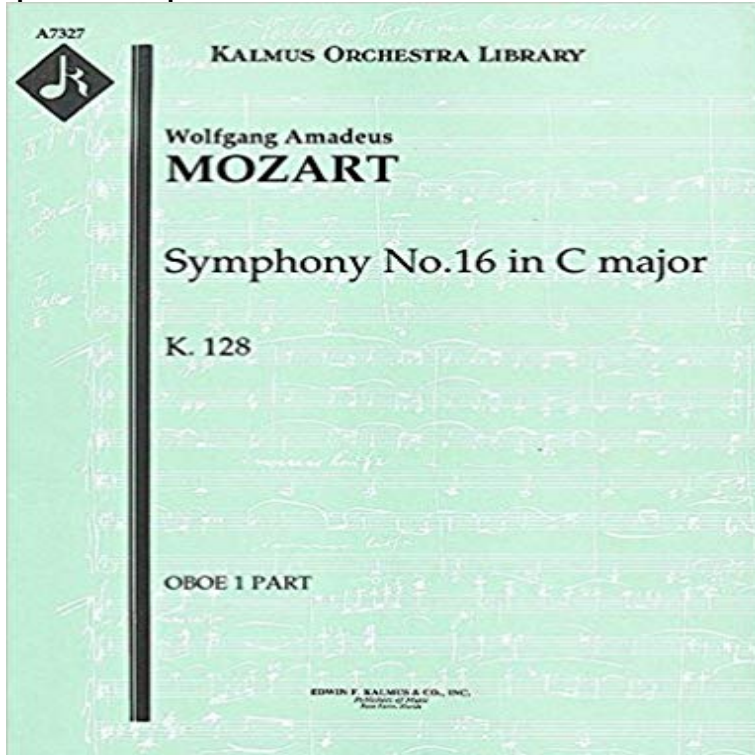

This symphony is one of many written during the period in which Mozart stayed in Salzburg, between two trips to Italy.
