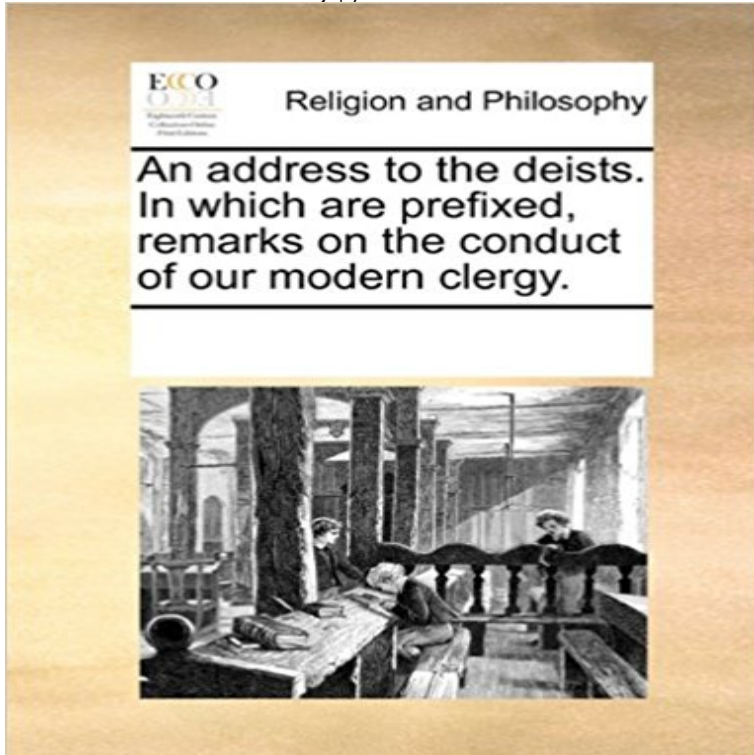


## An address to the deists. In which are prefixed, remarks on the conduct of our modern clergy.
