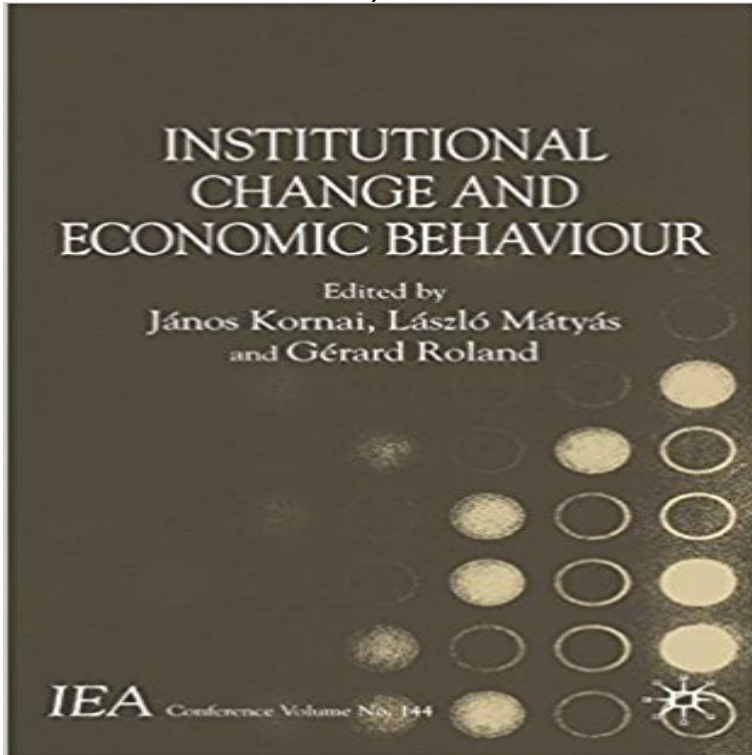


Institutional Change and Economic Behaviour (International Economic Association Series)
