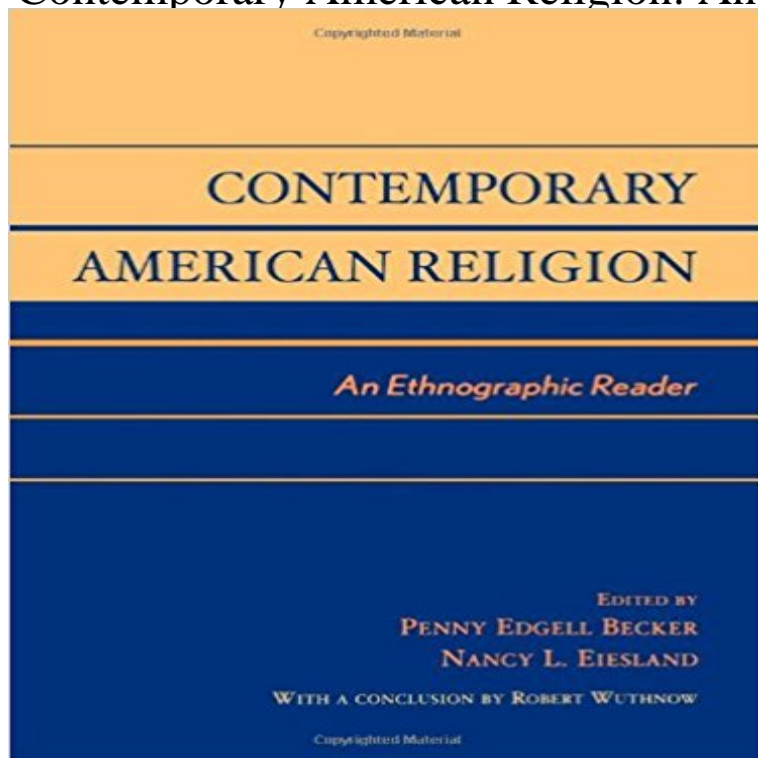


## Contemporary American Religion: An Ethnographic Reader
